users, 194 DDO/PAO and 532 Buyers/Consignee who are registered on GeM. Further, 5541 sellers and 1641 MSE sellers from these Islands have registered themselves for transacting on GeM.

It is worth mentioning here that despite the constraints on remoteness and connectivity in few Islands of this UT, there has been a considerable increase in the procurement through GeM over the past few years and the details are as under:

4-monthly installments of Rs.2000/- directly into the bank accounts of the farmers. So far, Rs 42.5582 crores has been disbursed till 14th installment. Release of 15th Installment for the period August to November is expected tentatively in the last week of October and 1st week of November, 2023.

State Bio-Control Laboratory

The State Bio-Control Laboratory (SBCL) started functioning at Haddo, Port Blair, for conservation & augmentation of natural enemies already present in the farmers' fields, multiplication of bio-agents in the laboratory and subsequent release in the farmers' fields against their target pests as well as monitoring and surveillance of insect-pests, diseases, weeds and bio-agents situation on major crops are being done.

The Laboratory has produced about 1,086.3 CC egg parasitoid of Trichogramma spp. and 4140 nos. of Tricho Cards have been prepared and 960 nos. of Tricho Cards released in the farmers field.

Training to Farmers and Officials

The main objective of ATMA is capacity building of farmers through Kisan Gosthies/Campaign, Farmers Training, Demonstrations, Kisan Melas, Exposure visit of Farmers, Setting up of Farm Schools and Farmers Award. Under ATMA, Trainings, Demonstrations, Farm Schools & awareness of different stakeholder Departments like Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Fisheries, Forest, Industries are being organized to provide the latest agriculture technologies in thematic areas to increase productivity in Agri. & Allied sector.
